CENTER BACK SEAM



DONE

Fold your skirt piece in half, right sides together, so the notches match.


(21-07, 21-08)

Pin the center back seam from the waist to the notch.

Stitch the center back seam at 15mm. Backstitch at each end.

(21-Y12)

Press the seam flat first, then open. Press only the stitched section of the seam. (21-P3)




Stand in front of a mirror.

Put the ZERO of the tape measure at your waist, with the rest hanging down the side of

your leg.

Stand on the tape measure. Put your heel sideways on the tape measure to hold it securely.

Make sure the tape is straight and the ZERO is still at your waist. Stand up straight. Move your foot to hold the tape measure set the ZERO end so right at your waist.
