# step

## **BOTTOM HEM**

12mm





Pin a 12mm hem along the bottom hem edge of each pant leg. (10-R8, 11-Y1)

Stitch each hem at 5mm. Use the edge your presser foot guide.

(10-R4, 10-R8, 11-Y2)

Press each hem flat. (11-P1)





Topstitching is the name given to any stitches that are sewn on top of the fabric so they show on the outside, sometimes for decoration.

Topstitching can be seed to hold the seam allowances against the fabric. It can be used decoratively, like in jeans.

Topstitching can be sewn in one line, or two, or three. Some topstitching can even be one of the decorative titches on your sewing machine!
